PLACEMENT HIGHLIGHTS 2021-22

The Placement season for the batch 2021-2022 started on a high note, and more than **135** companies visited the campus with a total number of offers for IGDTUW girls of circuit branches, i.e., CSE, IT, and ECE as **458**, including full-time employment (FTE) offers and dual offers (FTE and six-month internship). Thus about 322 offers were received by students in the year 2021-22 during the On-Campus drive.

The Highest Package rolled out was 55 Lakh CTC by Adobe which was a National Offer, whereas the highest International Offer package rolled out was 1.2 Crores CTC by Amazon Dublin. The highest (2-month) Internship Package rolled out was 1.6 LPM by Uber.

It is a matter of tremendous pride to share that there has been a rise from 224 FTE offers in 2016-17 to 391 FTE offers in 2020-21 and from 31 offers in 2016-17 to 322 INTERN offers in 2020-21.

As a result, more than 300 students received Paid summer internships at the beginning of the third year in the B.Tech Program, and more than 70 students in their final year B.Tech/M. Tech Program pursued six months paid internship.






