At the outset, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, IGDTUW welcomed the Hon'ble Chairman, Finance Committee and esteemed members of the Finance Committee of IGDTUW. The Agenda placed before the Finance Committee was taken up for deliberations. Agenda item-wise recommendations of the Finance Committee were as under:

Agenda Item No. 11.01 Opening Remarks by the Vice Chancellor.

The Vice Chancellor briefed the following progress report/achievements of the University to the Finance Committee:

- The University has been honoured with the prestigious 'University of the Year Award' in the category of universities in existence for 1-10 years, at the recently concluded FICCI Higher Education Excellence Awards 2021 ceremony.
- Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University for Women (IGDTUW) has been the flag-bearer for the unique "Education Mentoring Programme" in collaboration with Govt. of NCT of Delhi. Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia launched the programme on 20th March 2021. The programme was attended by principals, teachers and students of 184 Delhi Govt. Schools in the first phase, 250 mentor leaders (students of IGDTUW) will mentor 1000 mentees (government school students) and in Phase 2 they will mentor approximately 8000 to 10,000 students studying in classes 9th to 12th. Students of IGDTUW will work as Social Ambassadors for Knowledge Dissemination and Hand Holding of mentees in order to boost STEM education among girl students.

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- The University successfully conducted its Third Convocation on 28th December 2020 in blended mode. The Convocation was attended by Hon'ble Dy. Chief Minister of Delhi as Guest of Honor, Prof D P Singh, Chairman UGC as the Chief Guest. The University conferred degrees to 359 Undergraduate students, 119 Post Graduate students and 09 Ph.D. Students. Two Chancellor awards, Eleven Vice Chancellor awards and One Exemplary Performance award were given to the students for their outstanding performance.
- University conducted Second Alumni Meet and Industry Institute Networking Meet on 28th December 2020. Prestigious alumni awards were presented to various passed out students of the University who have shown extreme support for the University and have made the University immensely proud. The "Outstanding Young Alumnus Award" for outstanding involvement and achievement in post-graduate education, community contributions and career advancement were conferred to the alumni. The "Rising Star Award" was presented to alumni to recognize significant contributions to greater society through professional work.

The Finance Committee deliberated upon in detail and approved the audited Financial Statements of Accounts of IGDTUW for the year 2019-20.

Agenda Item No. 11.05

To consider and approve the grant of monthly stipend to full time Ph.D. Scholars from the Academic Year 2021-22

To attract more female students for pursuing Ph.D. in STEM, the University Research Board (URB) in its 6th meeting recommended the grant of Monthly stipend of Rs. 10,000/-, to full time Ph.D. Scholars from the Academic Year 2021-22. The Finance Committee appreciated the agenda and approved the proposal of grant of Monthly stipend of Rs. 10,000/- to full time Ph.D. Scholars for a period of five years from the date of admission from the Academic Year 2021-22 from University Receipts.

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Agenda Item No. 11.06

To consider and approve the revised Fee Structure for the IGDTUW Hostels for the Academic Session 2021-22.

The Finance Committee approved the Revised Fee Structure for the IGDTUW Hostels for the Academic Session 2021-22.

Agenda Item No. 11.07

With the permission of the Hon'ble Chairman, the following Supplementary Agendas were also presented before the Finance Committee for consideration: -

Supplementary Agenda-01

To consider and recommend the Establishment of University Development Corpus Fund

To meet the pace with the fast changing technology especially in the area of Big Data, Machine Learning, Artificial Intelligences, Information Security, VLSI Design, Robotics and Automation, the University has not only to revise its syllabus but also has to upgrade its Lab Infrastructure. Moreover, the University is presently operating from heritage campus which is more than 70 years old and requires continuous maintenance and up-gradation. The Committee noted that the GIA is being provided to the University in deficit financing mode by Govt. of NCT of Delhi. The Committee agreed that the modernization of the scientific & technological infrastructure and maintenance of the heritage buildings requires huge financial resources.

The Committee also considered the Section 7.(xxvii) of IGDTUW Act 2012 regarding creation of corpus fund. The Committee approved that University Development Corpus Fund may be generated utilizing the residual fee, other miscellaneous receipts of the University, consultancy fee, project overhead, interest, donations by the Industry/ Alumni etc. The fund will be utilized for the following purposes:

- Construction, renovation and landscaping of the existing /new buildings
- Setting up of State of Art Laboratories to meet the computing requirements for the students
- Conduct of extension activities, National/International conferences, seminars/workshops, research activities etc.
- To enhance quality and effectiveness of academics and research activities of the University by setting up Academic Chairs, student amenities, enhancing incubation facilities, promoting innovative projects, enhancing research and/or teaching assistantship etc.
- Support to the female students to attract to the University for pursuing research and higher education etc
- Fee waiver/ concession to the students who lost their parent(s) due to Covid-19 Pandemic/ low family income/ any other genuine reasons etc

The Committee also recommended that the detailed guidelines for the monitoring and utilization of the funds be developed by a Committee under the Chairmanship of Vice-Chancellor. The Finance Committee recommended the Establishment of University Development Corpus Fund.

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Supplementary Agenda -02

To consider and approve the Financial Assistance to Non-GATE qualified students pursuing M.Tech./M.Plan. Program

The Finance Committee noted the sharp decline in the number of female candidates applying for admission to the M.Tech/M.Plan Program and number of seats remains vacant. The Committee also observed that the other State University of Govt. of Delhi like NSUT is offering Financial Assistance to Non-GATE students pursuing M.Tech. Program. The Committee appreciated the concept as the expenditure incurred in the fellowship will reduce the expenditure incurred on engaging guest faculty for conduct of Lab classes etc.

The Finance Committee approved the Financial Assistance of Rs. 7,500/Month with upper limit of 10 students per branch to Non-GATE students pursuing M.Tech./M.Plan. Program based on their performance in the 1st semester from the Academic Year 2021-22 onwards.

Supplementary Agenda -03

To consider and approve the incentive for publication in SCOPUS and SCI/SCIE Index Journal by UG and PG students of the University

The Finance Committee appreciated the participation of the University in the various National and International rankings like NIRF, ARIIA, and QS Rankings etc. and noted the contribution of research publications in SCOPUS and SCI/SCIE Journals. The large number of papers can be published only by involving and motivating the UG and PG students of the University. The Finance Committee approved the incentive for publication in SCOPUS and SCI/SCIE Index Journal by UG and PG students of the University.

Supplementary Agenda -04

To consider and approve the empanelment of Delhi Tourism and Transportation Development Corporation Ltd. for works related to construction, upgradation of infrastructure

The Finance Committee has noted the agenda and desired that the empanelment of Delhi Tourism and Transportation Development Corporation Ltd. (DTTDC) for works related to construction, upgradation of infrastructure be placed in the next Finance Committee meeting with MoU specifying norms, terms & conditions, rate fixation etc.
