Guidance from the Pioneers: Seniors leading the way for Placement Success Under Viksit Bharat@2047

On April 2nd, 2024, the Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE), in collaboration with the Training and Placement (TNP) Department at Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University for Women (IGDTUW), orchestrated a successful interactive session on Guidance from the pioneers: Seniors leading the way for Placement Success, exclusively for pre-final year students of ECE-AI and ECE. The event was aimed to allow the students have a direct interaction with their immediate seniors, offering them a chance to contemplate on their journey and have first-hand account of the learnings from their seniors. The event garnered considerable interest, drawing an attendance of 150 students, in a one of its kind session. The organization of the event was smooth, led by the upcoming PR heads of ECE-AI and ECE, under the guidance of TNP ECE faculty coordinator Ms. Ramsha Suhail. The session featured Ms. Soumya Vats, upcoming FTE at Deutsche Bank, and Ms. Nikita Garg, upcoming FTE at Barclays, both of whom previously served as Public Relations (PR) heads of ECE 2024 in the TNP department of IGDTUW. During the session, the seniors discussed essential topics for securing favorable placements, emphasizing a blend of Data Structures and Algorithms (DSA), core subjects, and the importance of developing soft skills. Drawing from their experience as PR heads, the speakers provided insights into the expectations of company HR professionals from candidates and offered guidance on how students can meet these expectations effectively on an individual level.

The audience experienced an enlightening session as the speakers delved into detailed accounts of their interview experiences. They highlighted the significance of confidence during interviews, which can be a pivotal factor in setting a candidate apart and aiding in their selection. Alongside offering a comprehensive roadmap for excelling in placements, the speakers also discussed strategies for handling rejections and emphasized the value of participating in mock interviews. In essence, the session served as a comprehensive guide to the entire placement process, encompassing preparation strategies for online tests, interviews, and beyond.

Followed by this, the audience participated in a brief quiz featuring questions similar to those asked during the HR round of interviews, and the best answers were rewarded with goodies! Following this activity, Ms. Ramsha bestowed the speakers with tokens of appreciation, wishing them luck in their future endeavors. Additionally, all attendees received 'dream catchers' from the TNP department, serving as a reminder to persevere until reaching their goals.
