Important Instructions

1. All the eligible candidates have been notified through email today that they are requested to download MCA CET 2022 Admit Card from their respective login accounts on the Admission Portal (<u>https://igdtuw.in/IGDTUW_ADMISSION/login</u>). If any discrepancies are found, please email to the technical team at <u>noreply.igdtuw@gmail.com</u>, copy your email to <u>mcaadmissions@igdtuw.ac.in</u> on or before 7th July latest by 5:00 P.M.

2. To reiterate, MCA CET 2022 examination would comprise of 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ), 25 questions from each section. Refer to the syllabus for different sections.

3. Bring any one document, referred as Identity Proof (Adhaar Card/Election Card/Driving License/Passport) in Original for proof of identity.

4. Bring two printouts of admit cards.

5. No candidate will be allowed to appear for the examination without the admit card and any one identity proof as per point 3 above. The Admit Card and identity proof must be produced for verification in the examination hall.

6. Hand Bags, Purse, Electronic gadgets like Mobile, Calculator, Digital Watch, Bluetooth device, etc. are strictly NOT allowed inside the Examination Hall.

7. Report to University Campus (Examination Centre) at least 30 minutes before commencement of Written Examination.

8. No candidate will be allowed into the examination hall once the examination has started.

9. Candidate can leave the examination hall only after the scheduled time of exam is over.

10. Candidate should retain one copy of the Admit card (with invigilator's signature) till the admission process is finished, keep this safely and bring it at the time of counselling (if selected). Second copy should be handed over to the Invigilator at the time of written Test. Duplicate admit cards will not be issued after the test.

11. Issue of admit card does not necessarily mean acceptance of eligibility which will be further scrutinised at subsequent stages of the admission process.

12. Candidates must sit according to the seat allocated to them.

13. Use only Black/Blue ball point pen for filling of the OMR Answer Sheet.

14. The applicants are advised to check the location of University well in advance so that they can reach their examination centre/Hall without any problem/delay on the date of Entrance examination.

15. It is also informed that in any circumstances "NO CANDIDATES WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE EXAMINATION CENTRE AFTER THE SCHEDULED COMMENCEMENT OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATION".

16. All the applicants are advised to maintain COVID appropriate behaviour as per Govt. guidelines and general preventive measures during conduct of MCA CET Exam.
