Eligibility and Admission Procedure

Educational Qualification and Eligibility Conditions for Admission

The candidate seeking admission in B. Tech. (Lateral Entry) in 2nd year shall possess the essential qualification as per Table 1

Tech (Lateral Entry)	- Three-year regular Diploma in relevant branch /Equivalent stream awarded by any State/Central University/State Board of Technical Education/ Diploma recognized by AICTE, with 60% marks or equivalent CGPA in any branch of Engineering and Technology. - Those who are appearing in the Diploma final year (3rd year) examination may also apply, provided that they submit the proof of eligibility by 30th September, 2025.

Selection Criterion

- For 50% weightage:** Marks obtained in regular diploma in any branch of Engineering and Technology with a minimum of 60% marks in aggregate from any State Board of Technical Education/Diploma recognized by AICTE.
- For 50% weightage:** Personal Interaction/Interview.

Relaxation in Minimum Marks

Relaxation of 5% marks for candidates claiming reservation under OBC-NCL/ Defence sub-category (CW) and 10% for SC/ST/PwD sub category in the minimum marks criterion in the qualifying examination.

Reservation Policy

Delhi Region

Delhi Region Candidates (85% of seats) - A candidate passing the qualifying examination from a recognized School / College / Institute located within the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi will be considered for Delhi Region only.

Outside Delhi

Outside Delhi Region Candidates (15% of seats) - A candidate passing the qualifying examination from a recognized School / College / Institute located outside the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi will be considered for Outside Delhi Region only.

NOTE: For a candidate, who has passed the qualifying examination through Patrachar Vidyalaya, Delhi / National Institute of Open School, Delhi (NIOS), the criterion for deciding the region shall be the location of her centre of examination. In other words, if the centre of examination is located in the N.C.T. of Delhi, the candidate shall be considered under the Delhi Region and if the centre of examination is located outside N.C.T. of Delhi, she shall be considered under the Outside Delhi Region.

"A student who is a resident of a state Outside Delhi but has completed her diploma from an institute in Delhi will be considered under the General category for Delhi region admissions. However, if she wishes to seek admission under the OBC quota, she must provide a valid OBC certificate along with domicile proof from Delhi. If she is unable to provide domicile proof from Delhi, she will be considered under the General category for Delhi region admissions."

a) Scheduled Caste (SC): 15 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste candidates.

b) Scheduled Tribe (ST): 7.5 % of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Tribe candidates.

c) Other Backward Class (OBC- NCL): 27% of the total seats are reserved for

Other Backward Class (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates.

d) Economically Weaker Section (EWS): 10% of the total seats are reserved for EWS category as per the office order DHE.1 (119)/Estt. /2018- 19/2549-76 dated 17/06/2019

Note:

- i. In case of category (a) and (b), the vacant seats are interchangeable.
- ii. In case, sufficient numbers of eligible candidates from category (c) are not available, the vacancies will be treated as unreserved.
- iii. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to prove his/her eligibility for claiming reservation under any of the reserved categories. The candidates claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC/EWS categories will be required to upload scanned copy of the respective certificates and produce the original certificate of the respective reserved category/sub-category issued by the competent authority (as mentioned in this information brochure) in the respective institutes at the time of physical verification of the documents. If the reserved category certificate is not found in order, no benefit of the reserved category will be given and the candidate shall be considered for allotment in GENERAL category.
- iv. After exhausting the complete list of registered SC, ST, OBC and EWS candidates, an equivalent number of unreserved seats shall be created against the vacant reserved category seats in the "SPOT ROUND".

 - 3) Hostel and Mess Fee, if applicable will be paid separately.

c. Withdrawal Policy

The fee paid will be **Non-Refundable** for the counselling round except the security deposit of Rs 5000/-.

e. Documents required at the time of counselling:

Candidates are required to produce all the original certificates and two sets of self-attested photocopies in support of their candidature at the time of document verification.

Following is the list of essential documents required for the counselling:

1. Print-out of the online application form duly signed by the candidate with four passport size photo.
2. 10th Class Certificate (for Date of Birth proof)
3. Diploma /equivalent mark sheet
4. Consolidated mark sheet for Diploma & mark sheets of all years/semesters for Diploma.
5. Reservation for SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS is applicable as per university rules.
6. Caste Certificate for SC/ST/OBC-NCL /EWS if applicable. Candidates belonging to OBC-NCL & EWS will be required to submit the certificates issued on or later than 1st April, 2025.

7. ID Proof Aadhar card/Driving License/Voter ID/PAN Card
 8. Proof of CGPA/CPI conversion to percentage.
 9. Proof of payment of Rs.1000/- as registration fee.
 10. Medical Fitness Certificate
 11. Undertaking for Final Year Appearing Candidates. Candidates who are appearing in their final semester/final year examination (i.e. their qualifying degree result is awaited), have to fill the undertaking form. Any Seat offered to a final year appearing candidate will be purely provisional and subject to fulfillment of minimum eligibility criteria. If such candidate is unable to meet minimum eligibility criteria till the date declared by the University, her admission shall be cancelled and no fee will be refunded.
- f.** Candidate will be eligible for final seat allotment subject to the following conditions:
- Verification of all documents at the time of counselling and fulfilling of the eligibility criteria
 - Availability of seat in the required field and payment of fees for the program.
- g.** If the candidate fails to produce any required documents, her candidature is liable to be cancelled. In case, the candidate fails to fulfil minimum eligibility criteria, her admission shall be cancelled and no fee will be refunded. Admission may be cancelled even after seat allotment & submission of fee if any data/document provided by the applicant is found to be incorrect.

j. Important Pointers

Candidate will be eligible for final seat allotment subject to the following conditions:

- Verification of all documents at the time of counseling and fulfilling of the eligibility criteria.
- Availability of seat in the required field and payment of fees for the program.

Certificates required for claiming Reserved Seats

Candidates applying for any reserved seat (i.e., EWS, SC, ST, OBC-NCL, CW, PD, KM) must upload the scanned copy of the certificates (as applicable) as mentioned below at the time filling up of the ONLINE application form.

Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)/Other Backward Class (OBC-NCL):

For admission to a seat reserved for Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class (NCL), candidate must produce a certificate, in original, issued from an approved district authority stating the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class (NCL), to which the candidate belongs. A list of approved authorities is given below:

- a. District Magistrate/Additional Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner/Collector/Additional Deputy Commissioner/Deputy Collector/1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate / City Magistrate (not below the rank of 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate), Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- b. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- c. Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidates and/or his/her family normally resides.
- d. Administrator/Secretary to Administration/Development Officer (Laccadive & Minicoy Islands).

NOTE:

1. The candidate seeking admission under reserved categories has to mandatorily upload the caste/ category certificate in his/her name at the time of filling up of the ONLINE form. The certificate in the name of either of the parents (mother/father) or any other family member is not acceptable and the candidate will not be entitled even for provisional admission.
2. The reservation certificate should be issued from the respective state/region in which the reservation is being claimed, e.g., in case, a candidate claims the seat reserved for the Delhi Region category, she has to bring SC/ ST/OBC certificate issued by Govt. of NCT of Delhi and should have also passed her qualifying examination from a School / College / Institute located in National Capital Territory of Delhi.
3. OBC (NCL) candidates are required to produce a caste certificate issued after March 31, 2025 from the authorities as mentioned above. However, if the certificate is issued prior to March 31, 2025, it must be accompanied with an additional certificate regarding the present non-creamy layer status of the candidate, issued by the same competent authority. This additional certificate must have reference of his/her already issued original caste certificate.
4. Students claiming OBC reservation under Delhi region will be admitted in this

category on the submission of a certificate to this effect from the Competent Authority of the Government of NCT of Delhi. Certificate issued by Govt. of India or any state government will not be accepted under any circumstances. A certificate issued by a Competent Authority of Delhi to an individual on the basis of Caste Certificate of her parents from another state will be accepted for claiming a seat under OBC Category **IF AND ONLY IF** the caste is in the list of notified OBC list by Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

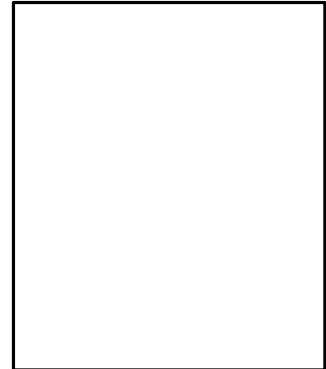

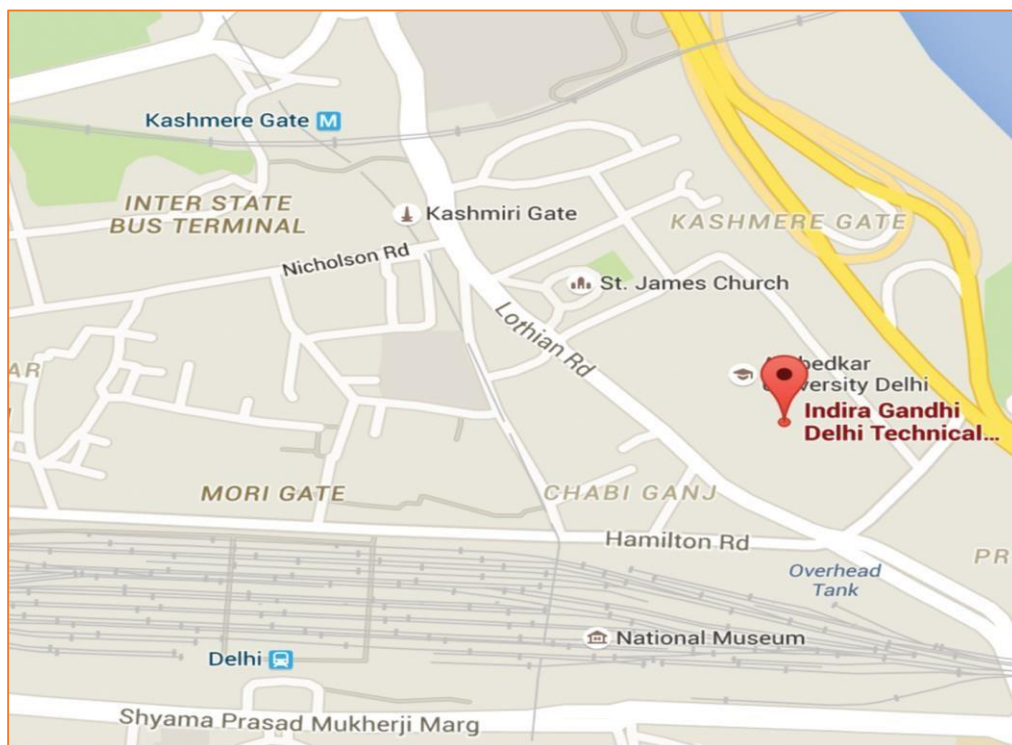
