All the students who are awarded with Exemplary Performance Certificate and Plaque (in case of Exemplary Performance Students)/ Certificate of Merit and Gold Medal (in case of Gold Medalists), M. Tech Degree awarded and all the students who are awarded Ph. D Degree in the year 2020 are cordially invited to physically attend the Convocation.

All other students who graduated in academic Year 2019-20 shall attend the Convocation in Online Mode Only. Please visit University Website <u>www.igdtuw.ac.in</u> for further details.

Detailed Guidelines are:-

- 1. All the above mentioned students invited for attending convocation are advised to take note of the following important instructions for necessary information and compliance:
- 2. <u>Prior Intimation</u>: As per list notified on the University website, all the students who wish Exemplary Performance Certificate and Plaque (in case of Exemplary Performance Students)/ Certificate of Merit and Gold Medal (in case of Gold Medalists)/M. Tech Degree/Ph. D degree to be conferred "inperson" are required to register themselves and their submit consent through Online Mode (No other mode of registration is accepted) latest by 17Th December, 2020 (05:00 p.m.) positively, failing which the Exemplary Performance Certificate and Plaque/ Certificate of Merit and Gold Medal/ M. Tech Degree awardees/Ph. D degree awardees would be conferred "in-absentia".

- <u>Admit Card:</u> The Admit card will be issued online on receipt of consent from the student. For that visit University Website <u>www.igdtuw.ac.in</u>. Students without proper 'Admit Card' will NOT be allowed to attend the Convocation.
- 4. <u>Reporting for Convocation</u>: Convocation will be held in IGDTUW Auditorium on 28th December, 2020 at 11:30 A.M for which only medallion students, M. Tech and Ph. D awarded student must report at the respective "Attendance Counter" which will be established in the University on 28th December, 2020 at 8.30 A.M. and get their seat number in the allotted.
- 5. <u>Convocation Gowns</u>: All the students will compulsorily wear gowns, which will be available on hire from the "Gown Counters" established in the University on 28th December, 2020 at 8.30 A.M. The gowns will be issued against deposit of Rs.500 per gown as Security (refundable). The hire charges @ Rs.100 per gown will be deducted when the gowns are deposited back after the Convocation at the Gown Counter. If the Gowns are not deposited by 3 P.M on 28th December, 2020, full security charges will be forfeited. For smooth conduction of Convocation, gown must be collected from "Gown Counters" on 28th December, 2020 at 10.00 A.M. All the M. Tech Degree awarded students, Ph.D awarded students, Exemplary Performance students and Gold medalists must collect the Gown, failing which they would not be allowed to attend the Convocation. The students will occupy their allotted seats strictly as per "Seats Allocation".

6. General Instructions:

- Parent/Spouse may accompany the student. Details of the same are to be submitted through online mode latest by 15Th December, 2020 (05:00 p.m.) to ensure necessary seating arrangements.
- Students are requested not to bring any brief case, bag, Camera, mobile phone, any electronic gadgets, matchbox, water bottle and eatables inside the University. Students are advised to make their own arrangements for safe custody of their belongings as the University will find it difficult to arrange the same.
- Ensure that all outstanding fees, fines, books, and equipments are settled. If you have any
 outstanding fees, fines, books, or equipments, you will not be qualifying for the award of the
 degree. Hence, make sure to clear all your No Dues (if any) before 20th December, 2020.
- Due to security reason in the University Campus, vehicles would not be allowed inside the University Campus.
