



Erudite 2022

(Online: 16th to 24th September, Offline: 30th September)

The Arc IGDTUW had organized an Ideathon, Erudite, on 1 October, 2022 in collaboration with Innerve, the annual technical fest of IGDTUW. It was our first major event, with 402 registered teams.

Shortlisting for the offline idea presentation was done after two online rounds, judged by our panel of talented innovation enthusiasts. The first round was on Unstop with the participants submitting their ideas in the form and the panelists selecting the ideas for the presentation submission. After initial shortlisting rounds involving idea submissions and presentation submissions, a total of 11 teams were shortlisted for the offline idea pitching round.

The offline idea pitching round was held in Indira Gandhi Delhi Technical University of Women, Kashmere Gate, and saw an enthusiastic audience along with the ingenious shortlisted participants, with people enjoying the pitches of the teams. The amateurs and the artful alike enraptured the audience.

Of these enterprising teams, the winning team was Tuvoi, whose idea was about an Electric Vehicles charging site identification model, the first runner up was Padawans, and the second runner up were Cheque-In with their fraud detection from cheques and Debug Geeks with their sport facility booking system. The final round was judged by Dr Poonam Bansal and Dr Nonita Sharma, both excelling professors in the field of Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence.

The event was unsponsored, but with a prize pool of Rs. 10,000, and winners had the opportunity to get their idea patented.
